You will have a Ph.D. and will be expected to have shown significant achievement in research in the broad area of cellular and molecular biology, preferably with skills associated with immunology and/or microbiology in the animal or medical disciplines. Dependent upon appointment level, you will be expected to develop an internationally competitive research profile or have the potential to develop such a profile over time. The research area will be complementary to one or more areas of current strength at Keele, within the School of Life Sciences. Whilst not excluding any particular research theme, you would be expected to contribute to cell and molecular research within the School, preferably within Cell and Molecular Medicine research area. Other potential areas of interaction might include the Centre for Applied Entomology and Parasitology (CAEP), or Neuroscience. Each of these areas links staff in the School of Life Sciences to the Research Institute for Science and Technology in Medicine within the Faculty of Health.

Applications are therefore welcomed from individuals committed to high-quality teaching and research and with a good track record of achievement. You will be able to incorporate your knowledge and experience of the discipline into exciting learning experiences for undergraduate and postgraduate students. It is our expectation that you will qualify for inclusion in future Research Excellence Framework submissions in the UK.
